Partnership with Forest Hills Baptist

Dear Una Baptist -

Thank you for the privilege of serving as your transition team during this important season in the life of Una Baptist. Thank you also for your patience; we know this is a time of change, and with change, there is always a little anxiety. So thank you for continuing to pray with and for us as we seek the Lord's will for this congregation.

As you know, our team has two main goals:

1. To extend the financial life of Una Baptist.

2. Provide a wise pathway forward for Una Baptist.



We want to give you a report on our progress toward both of those goals:

As you heard at our last business meeting, Una Baptist's financial position is improving, and as of the end of August, our year-to-date revenues exceed our year-to-date expenses. That is good news.

At the same time, it's important to remember that the primary reasons why the financial position is improving are because we are not currently paying a salary for a senior pastor, and we are not paying any expenses related to preaching on Sundays. We are grateful to both Forest Hills and the Nashville Baptist Association for covering those expenses on an ongoing basis.

This Sunday, we will hear a message from Chad Mize, and then Jerry Winfield will be back in the pulpit for at least the first couple of weeks in October.

We are excited about the prayer walks scheduled for Sept. 30 and Oct. 21. These are important opportunities for us, along with the congregation of Forest Hills, to pray for our community.

We are also excited about the Fall Festival with Trunk or Treat on October 28, and are grateful for the hard work of the planning team in putting it together.

We are planning a church workday to be held on a Saturday in November (date forthcoming) in which members of Forest Hills Baptist will team up with members of Una Baptist to provide the labor to help with lingering projects around the church campus. We are working with Daniel and Mark to identify and prioritize the list of projects.

One last item from the team. We are currently deeply engaged in prayer and discussions about the future of Una Baptist. We aren't ready to give a report on the road forward yet; we want to make sure that when we do, we can speak very clearly and specifically as to the recommendation. But we ask you to continue to pray for the Lord to go before us as we seek His will in the next phase of life and ministry for Una Baptist.

We feel confident we will be able to deliver a recommendation to the congregation by our December deadline.


