On **November 12th** there will be an important time of discussion on this matter after Connection Groups in the Sanctuary. The plan is to allow 90 minutes to discuss and ask questions you may have after the recommendation's "answers." THIS IS A DISCUSSION ONLY! NO vote will be taken!!!

Pray and discuss among yourselves how you feel about the possibilities of this merger. Then, on

December 3rd after Connecion Groups we will come together to VOTE on allowing our Deacons to begin meeting with their leadership as we begin moving forward in getting more answers on what a merger our two churches would look like. The December 3rd's vote is not a vote to merge! If we agree to let the deacons move forward, a "merge vote" would be planned at a later date. Please pray for Una Baptist Church and 'Christ for the Nations' Church as we pursue God's Will and His Blessings.
