#### **Merge Update**

"The leaders of Una Baptist Church and Christ for the Nations Church of Nashville are recommending to the members of each church that we formally merge into one congregation. This recommendation comes from careful discussion and prayer among our leadership teams, carefully listening to our two congregations, and detailed planning. We offer this recommendation with a growing sense of excitement and hope for our future.

The decision to merge, however, belongs to the members of each of our churches. Our desire is to offer you complete transparency, so that you have everything you need to make an informed and confident decision. In this packet you will find a summary of our recommendation, in a Q&A format; a timeline of events; and copies of each official document."

This is the preamble to the packet that is currently in process. That document will include: Plan of Merger, Statement of Faith, Constitution & By-Laws, Church Covenant, & Charter. Leadership meetings are scheduled for January 4 and January 7 with additional congregation discussions in the month of January. There is an optimistic plan that could see final merge votes as soon as the month of February.

Please pray for the Merge Team and actively share your thoughts and priorities for their edification. Further, make it a priority to pray for the congregation of Christ for the Nations in the way that you would pray for your child's future spouse. Would you go see their school play? Would you attend their recital? Would you seek and even create opportunities to get to know them with the understanding that the time would be a little awkward for all parties, but you would aspire to put your best impression on display seeking to nurture a good relationship for generations to come.




#### **Una Church Conference**
