

Covid-19 Re-Entrance to Church Services: *Rollout Plan for May 31-June*

■ Church Worship **ONLY** beginning on May 31 and going through June

- ◆ **No** Sunday School or other small groups
- ◆ **No** Wednesday night activities
- ◆ Worship Service will begin at 10:30 and end by 11:30
- ◆ **PLEASE** wear a mask during the time you are at Church, even while singing. This may seem strange to you (it is!) but when we sing, there is more sharing of your breath with others. This is a protection for you and a way of respecting others around you
- ◆ **IF** we are in Phase 3 by July, Small Groups will resume **July 5** with Wednesday nights resuming the following Wednesday **July 8**. We will make that assessment/decision before the month of July and inform you.

■ Upon entering the building:

- ◆ Only one Greeter at the door to open for people entering
- ◆ We will not have a paper bulletin to pass out
- ◆ Only the main doors (glass doors) will be unlocked for worship time
- ◆ No physical contact
- ◆ Enter early enough to find a seat that is socially distant from others
- ◆ A bottle of hand sanitizer will be in the foyer for your use
- ◆ There will be **NO** coffee or refreshments
- ◆ Maintain proper Social Distancing in all areas: church entrance, auditorium, and when you exit

■ Worship will begin at 10:30 and last for one hour

- ◆ We will encourage people to arrive early and find seating appropriately to maintain proper distance. Sitting with your family will allow us to have more seating
- ◆ **No** GREETING time
- ◆ **No** Choir until notified (further notification)
- ◆ Offering plate will not be passed—plates will be set up at the back of the auditorium for people to place offerings into following the service
 - ◆ The offering will be placed in the safe by the Usher. Counting the offering will be done on the following day by our staff
- ◆ We will attempt to video the service and put it online for those who cannot attend

■ **No BLAST** for the month of June and until we are safely in Phase 3

- **No Wee Worship/Church Child Care** for the month of June and until we are safely in Phase 3
- We will **NOT** have communion during the month of June. When it returns, we will modify how it is done
- **OBVIOUSLY**—if you do not feel well, please stay home. If you feel that your health makes you more vulnerable, please stay home. We will do all we can to share the service with you through video or at the least, through audio. **SENIOR CITIZENS: this is especially for you.** This age group is the most vulnerable. During these early months, you may elect to remain quarantined. Please come, but only as you feel sufficiently safe to attend.
- We will have a cleaning crew to make sure that things have been wiped down before you arrive, and will sanitize it once again at the conclusion of Church
