The deacons made a motion that all Designated Funds be moved to General Funds—so money may be utilized if/as needed without church action in the future. In discussion, a Deacon shared if/when our church gets into a healthier financial state, monies should be returned to designated funds status as before. That motion passed overwhelmingly.

Our members of the Transition Team will be Jim Fox, Joy Brewer, and Glenna Colbert. There is two exclusions that pertain to the Transition Team. The Transition Team cannot 1) act as Trustees re: property sale or such), 2) They cannot make any decisions re: personnel at Una Baptist. Una Baptist still has power over those decisions.

"God's Grace has saved you because of your faith in Christ your salvation doesn't come from anything you do. It is God's Gift."

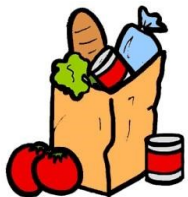
